

somalias recent election as a nonpermanent member of the un security council marks a significant milestone for the african nation after decades of conflict and instability somalia now has the opportunity to contribute to global peace and security efforts the countrys struggles against islamist militants grant it a unique perspective on these issues the un security council established in 1945 to uphold international peace comprises 15 members including somalia as the latest addition serving for a twoyear term starting in january somalia aims to advocate for multilateralism and uphold international law principles outlined in the un charter
